Report to the SAMSC General Meeting, Tuesday 19 June 2018

The 2018 Training programme is in full swing following a slow start due to the adverse weather in the first quarter. Training is being advertised principally through email notification to all registered marshals via the MSA, and through chief marshals and club training champions, with the next newsletter due out in the coming fortnight. Details are also held on the Association website, and the SMMC web pages.

Attendance at training has been steady, but still not reflective of the numbers actually marshalling. That said following considerable enthusiasm by speed clubs in central/southern Scotland we held a successful training day at Kames where we managed to welcome a new marshal or two to the select band of Scottish speed marshals. We have a second speed marshals training day on 29 July in northern Scotland at Boyndie and we would welcome the support of speed clubs and organisers in the north.

We are also responding to marshals requests for more fire training this year, with incident and fire training planned for Boyndie on 29 July – suitable for all disciplines, but particularly targeted at rally marshals. Please encourage your marshals to register on the Association website.

We are now starting to consider requirements for 2019 and ***I need input from clubs***. What are your training needs for 2019? If I do not hear from your club I will assume your marshals/volunteers need no training and will not make any provision. I need to know by the end of July so that I can prepare budgets for submission in early September. Please respond to me at training@scottishmotorsportsclubs.co.uk

I still have some provision I can make this year so if you have a requirement for training please tell me now! Availability of instructors can be a challenge especially if training is requested last minute. All our instructors are volunteers, and tend to be extremely busy with motorsport generally and so early requests are appreciated.

The MSA are starting to try to encourage a greater regional view to the training being offered, building on the foundations we have set up in Scotland. All the regional training co-ordinators met recently and increased regional co-ordination is one way we can try to make the most from the limited funds available from the BMSTT.

We recently supported the MSA running a Safety Car training event in Scotland, and will be supporting the SMRC with the inaugural day in their Marshals Development Programme at the end of this month. What do your club marshals need?
