

Scottish Karting Report to SACC – March 2018

The first meeting at WSKC was very poorly attended with a grid of only 38. The numbers in the UK are well down, but unfortunately the extremities of the country seem to feel the effect more. Central areas of the UK have big numbers, so a slight drop is not too bad. Permits are down almost 9% from 2016 to 2017. When numbers are low folk go elsewhere for bigger grids. Non-regulated events seem to grow and the irony is that these events use the Blue Book as their yardstick.

This year sees Bambinos racing from the age of 7 in a British Championship. I final test event will be hosted by WSKC in April.
