

**Motorsport UK Safety Committee
Report of Meeting 12th. August 2020**

The most recent meeting of the MSUK Safety Committee was held using Zoom on 12th. August 2020.

The updated minutes of the previous meeting, which was held on 16th. April 2020 were accepted and will be circulated.

A new item, (Declaration of Interests) will be added to all future agenda.

Covid-19 precautions were discussed and it was appreciated that the subject will be continually updated when necessary. It was noted that Motorsport UK's new paperless systems and flexibility had been used as a benchmark across the world and together with the work done by Motorsport Australia, have been adopted by many other ASNs and commended by the FIA.

Matters discussed included safety car driving requirements, fuel storage at circuits, referrals from committees, proactive safety initiatives.

An ad-hoc committee would be formed to look at matters relating to Hill Climbs, and it was noted that the Cross Country Challenge Review Report would be ready for the next meeting.

It was noted that there had not been a Council meeting since the last Safety Committee meeting.
