

SAMSC Autotest Co-ordinator Report.

Not much to report on from the last time, I was hopeful we might be able to hold the GMSC counter in the Scottish Autotest Championship - the Andy Wilson Memorial Autotest but due to venue constraints and travel restrictions probably not being relaxed in the near future this will have to be postponed,

hopefully we can hold enough events during 2021 to warrant running a Championship, if not we will just have to start again in 2022.

I have not had any correspondence from clubs who were due run events this year I can only assume no events have been held.

While the British Street Car Cup has been postponed until 2022 and will be launched as a multi discipline series I believe there are still some clubs in SAMSC who wish to run some AutoSolos in 2021 before the launch in 2022, we will have to watch this space.

My first meeting of the MS UK Autotest Committee was very informative and it was good to get an overview of Autotesting / AutoSolo across the whole of the UK, some areas have oversubscribed entries and others have to run multi permit events to break even, it proves even more that if we want grass roots motorsport to flourish we all have to work together and embrace change and new ideas.
