Mailing List

At the March meeting we heard of a few people not receiving agendas, etc..

Eventually I found that half a dozen people, out of 260 or so, were missing from the mailing list having previously been on it, and all of them were Virgin broadband customers. All of the ntlworld addresses, except one, were gone. The exception, Peter Weall's, has a history of two-way correspondence with David Law and myself, which is a factor considered in spam-weighting algorithms.

Virgin downloads to customers an anti-spam program which doesn't just bin messages that it thinks are spam, it also unsubscribes the user from the mailing list, if an "unsubscribe" link is available.

I put those addresses back on the mailing list, and it seems to be working fine again.

I advise you all to add the lock@ and davidlaw@ and saccnews@scottishcarclubs.com addresses to your white-list or trusted senders list or whatever it is called in your particular setup. That might help if there is another outbreak of this anti-spam behaviour, not necessarily confined to Virgin customers.
