

SACC AUTOSOLO SERIES

The first two events in the three round 2016 Autosolo Series have taken place since the last SACC meeting in March.

The Knockhill round run by Glenrothes MSC was a first class event, with a good mix of cars entered ranging from seriously fast Lotus Elises to a Skoda Superbe and a Smart Car.

This was the first competition for a good number of the 26 entry and indeed for the outright winner Michael Sciberas in his Elise.

7 teams were entered - some from clubs (Scottish Sporting CC, Glenrothes MSC) and some just matching up on the day.

Passenger rides courtesy of Go Motorsport took place at lunchtime and also after the event while results were being finalised, before trophies were presented by Ian Forrest from Knockhill.

Kames on 5th June run by EACC was another good event with fantastic weather and 18 entries.

Again a number of club team entries and passenger rides. Everybody enjoyed the well run event and the running commentary on the PA.

Both events so far have used the same standardised regulations, entry fee, documentation, final instructions, diagrams, on course markers, layout numbering and arrowing, and results etc. and have both featured fast open tests.

The final round in the series is in the hands of Scottish Sporting CC at Ardeer on Sunday 21st of August, and work has already commenced on organising this event where it is hoped that everything will be pulled together to get a good entry, spectators, commentary etc. on the day.
