Competitor Medicals

- Recognition that current system is cumbersome and needs review
- Largely MUK tries to follow FIA pattern but not always appropriate and doesn't comfortably sit with NHS specialist access etc
- Discussion about whether medicals should be done on entry to the sport rather than (say) at 18. E.g. There is little evidence for having ECG at 45 as opposed to any other age.
- Self declaration needs to be more robust. People tend to lie about their health, and it is getting increasingly difficult to get GPS to do medicals.
- Could we adopt more general sporting regulations to bring us more in line with other sports, highlighting the necessary differences for Motorsport?

Incident reporting and Staffing

- The Committee is going to seek to get more incident reports to try to gauge the response of the Rescue and Medical services in each case.
- Paramedics are already indemnified by Motorsport UK. In order to help medical recruitment, the possibility of indemnifying junior medical staff perhaps once or twice a year as a "taster" is being explored.
