Autotest Championship report

63 Car Club held their round at Thainstone Mart, they had 16 entries but only 12 started, there was a good selection of tests on a really good surface and was well supported by the championship contenders.

James Morrison took FTD. in his Mini special, Gary Clark was 2nd in his Mazda MX5 and Alan Dalgarno was 3rd in his Fiesta special.

The most recent event held in the championship was the Oakbank Waste Management Ltd. Autotest, there was a disappointing entry of 7 cars, I was very surprised since historically that region usually has very good numbers for their events.

Gary Clark and Paul Davidson made the long trip down and Gary finished 2nd o/all and Paul 4th o/all.

The [Championship tables after 6 rounds \(on the Autotest page of the SAMSC site\)](#) show Gary Clark at the top with 178 points, followed by James Morrison on 155 points and then Alan Dalgarno on 139 points, with 3 rounds still to go this could all change after dropped scores come into play.

As the next 2 rounds are also being run alongside the Scottish Road Car series AutoSolo events, there are no reverse manoeuvres in the tests.

The final event of the season at Leuchars WILL have reverse manoeuvres in some of the tests, I am also hoping to run at least 1 tandem test.

An additional twist just to keep things interesting will be that all the points awarded for this event will be multiplied by 1.5 - ie first o/all would normally be awarded 20 points for this event will be 30 points and so on down the tables.
