Report to the SAMSC General Meeting, Tuesday 17 September 2019

The training programme has continued with rally marshals training on Mull, training for medical students at Knockhill, and for recovery operators in July. Additionally SDMC have run some marshals training in advance of the Grampian Rally.

Most recently SMMC and SAMSC have run training for rally marshals in the run up to the two closed road rallies in Scotland this autumn. This was well attended in Melrose with good feedback. It is, however, unfortunate that some of the subsequent discussion on Facebook has focused on how it had been publicised. The event was publicised on the association website, shared on social media, and sent out through the secretary's mailing lists to all clubs and marshals on the local database. Unfortunately it has been commented that some clubs haven't shared this information amongst their members, to their disappointment. It would be helpful if clubs could promote events to ensure their members have the opportunity to get involved in training.

The invitation for grant aid funding bids for 2020 has been received and planning is underway for next season's training. We have been liaising with training co-ordinators across the UK to ensure consistency of training. We urgently need any training requirements from clubs for next year. To date requests have been received from marshals in the Dunoon area and from the South of Scotland Car Club. I would be grateful for any other requests to training@scottishmotorsportsclubs.co.uk before 23 September.

Plans for the remainder of 2019 are provided overleaf, although regrettably the organisation of these events falls on a very small number of people, which is leading to delays in promoting events.
