Dear All,

In conjunction with the Sprint & Hill Climb Sub Committee, the MSA Safety and Technical Departments have produced some guidance for event organisers who may wish to accept entries for Hybrid or Electric vehicles. The intention of the guidance is to ensure that adequate measures are in place to insure compliance with the vehicle manufacturers guidelines, the MSA Yearbook and of course a safe event.

Please be aware that you will require specific Hybrid & Electric vehicle pre-authorisation, from the MSA, prior to accepting entries for Hybrid or Electric vehicles. Can you please therefore make specific reference in your Championship or Permit applications of this requirement, so that the necessary review can take place.

We would also mention that the MSA are reviewing the training needs of those organisers that wish to run Hybrid or Electric vehicles. If any guidance is required for Scrutineering Hybrid or Electric vehicles please liaise directly with the MSA Technical Department.
