ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Highland Car Club (HCC) Ltd will hold a Clubmans/PSA Permit Autotest on **Sunday 12th May 2019** at Fendom Airfield, TAIN.
This event will be a counter for the Scottish Autotest Championship 2019.
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Codes of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that HCC may issue for the event.
The Motorsport UK Championship Registration number is 76/2019
3. MSA Permit Number: To be confirmed
4. The event is open to any person who is a fully elected member of a recognised Club within SAMSC, and fully paid up members of HCC & paid up members of the following clubs: 63CC, ADMC, SDMC, 750MC, Skye Rally Club & Caithness CC.
5. All competitors must produce a valid Club membership card at signing on.
6. The Programme of the meeting will be as follows:
Scrutineering starts at 9.30hrs
Any competitor not signed on by 10.45hrs may be excluded.
First car starts at 11.00hrs.
7. The event will consist of classes as follows:
Class One – FWD
Class Two – RWD
Class Three – Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars
Class Four – Production Car not currently taxed or MOT'd
Class Five – Specials
Class Six- Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – **Must be Standard Production Cars**
8. **The entry list opens on receipt of these ASRs and closes finally on 12th may 2019**
The entry fee is £15. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Incomplete entries and entries not accompanied by the entry fee may be returned.

12. The maximum entry for the meeting including reserves is 30 and the minimum is 5. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event.

14. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event in accordance with C5.1.2 to 5.2.3
15. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with O.5.1.
16. Details of the tests will be issued on the day.
17. Tests will not permit an optional direction of travel to be followed.
18. Practising will not be allowed.
19. Each driver will have at least two runs at each test, the fastest of these two runs at each test will count for the results.
20. Cars will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers.
21. The method of timing will be by stopwatch
22. The starting signal will be by marshal instruction with 3, 2, 1, go.
23. The order of attempting tests will be numerical within each class.
24. All competitors must attempt all tests in the same vehicle to be classed as a finisher.

25. All other regulations of the MSA apply as written except for M 4.2 – road cones may be used as pylons and may be under 1m tall.
