Supplementary Regulations

1. Glenrothes Motor Sport Club Ltd. Will promote a Clubman status Autotest / P.C.A. on Sunday 19th April 2020 at Knockhill Racing Circuit, near Dunfermline, Fife, KY12 9TF.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK Incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions of the promoting club may issue.
3. MSA Permit No. TBA / TBA
4. The Clubman event is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club and also members of the following invited Clubs – Dunfermline C.C, 750MC, Stonehaven & Dist. M.C., Scottish Sporting C.C., South of Scotland C.C., 63C.C., E.U.M.S.C., Solway C.C., Highland C.C, Aberdeen & District M.C., Berwick & Dist. M.C., East Ayrshire C.C., Knockhill M.S.C., Coltness .C. C. and Saltire Rally Club
5. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising Club and also members of Clubs which are affiliated to the following invited association, the Scottish Association of Motor Sports Clubs
6. **All Drivers and Passengers must produce a valid club membership card and a valid RS Clubman Licence. From 01st January 2020 all competitors require a minimum of an RS Clubman Licence.** this does not affect those who already have any form of a Competition Licence. The Licence is **FREE** and it only takes a few minutes to apply on line at <https://rsclubman.motorsport.org/...> Entrants under the age of 18 years are required to complete a paper form as it requires to be signed for by a parent or guardian, these forms will be available at the event or can be downloaded from the MotorSport UK website. To save delays at signing it would benefit everybody if online registration was carried out before the event.

GMSC Membership Costs £10.00 per Adult, £12.00 per Couple, £2.00 per Junior (16 or under) and may be applied for on the day.

7. The programme of the the meeting will be – Scrutineering starts at 10.00 am, and any competitor not signed on by 10.45 am, may be excluded. First car starts at 11.00 am.
8. The event will consist of 6 Classes as follows -
 1. Front wheel drive saloons.
 2. Rear wheel drive saloons.
 3. Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars.
 4. Production Cars not currently taxed or MOT'D
 5. Specials.
 6. Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – **Must be Standard Production Cars**
9. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations M 4.1 – 4.7
Drivers aged 14 may compete in the PCA and must carry a passenger who has a full RTA licence and be experienced in Autotests or AutoSOLOs.
- 10 Drivers aged 16, or drivers aged 17 who do not hold a full RTA Licence, may compete provided
p The vehicle must be defined as a 'Touring Car'
Engine Capacity must not exceed 1400 cc.
Forced Induction is not permitted.
Cabriolet/Sports Cars may compete with the hood/hardtop removed with the following restrictions.

The passenger in a Cabriolet/Sports Car with the hood or hardtop fitted must aged 12 years or over and at least 135cm in height. r

The passenger in a Cabriolet/Sports Car without the hood or hardtop fitted must be aged 16 years or over and be at least 135cm in height.

11 Child Protection – If competitor is under 18, Entry Form must be countersigned by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian, or an appointed representative must be present during the competition and must sign on the competitors signing on sheet. If a parent or guardian will not be present, a representative must be appointed, must show written authority from the parent or guardian to act as the child's representative and must countersign the competitors signing on sheet.

12 Awards will be presented as follows in the event-

1st in Class – an award providing 3 or more start in the class.

15 .The maximum entry for the meeting is 60 and the minimum is 10. Should any of the above figures be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate the classes or cancel the event. Entry will be selected by receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if cancelled 24 hours prior to the event.

17. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event or within 2 hours of the last car finishing the event (D26.1.2).

18. Any protests must be lodged as per (C5.1.2.)

19. Details of the 5 Tests will be available at signing on.

20. Each driver will have 2 runs at each test with the best 1 run to count.

21. Timing will be by hand held watches or electronic timing equipment – whichever is available.

22. The starting signal will be 3,2,1, GO or Lights.

23. The order of attempting test will be in class order.

24. Practising will not be allowed.

25. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organisers.

26. Markings and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.

27. All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following, which are modified-

(M.6.6.) Pylons may be less than 1 Metre high.

I Declare –

- 1.I I have been given the opportunity to read the General Regulations of Motor Sport UK and if any the Supplementary Regulations for this event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so.
