Hi Pete

I am aware that the SAMSC meeting tomorrow night has been postponed but I thought I should update you from Rallies Committee nonetheless (copied to Gordon for info also):

(1) Co-driver training module will be available on training hub. Link will be sent to RS Club and Inter Club Licence Holders and Clubs.

A presentation will be distributed for Club nights.

Not a requirement for licensing yet.

(2) First Aid kits - will not be put under regulation but MSUK will research something suitable to recommend.

(3) SRSRs update available end Apr/May. A lot of amendments/additions - check.
Implementation in July

(4) New safety posters included in SRSR update - recommend only for use in event programmes rather than printed for new signage. New signage will have to be discussed at RCtee level as is regulation change.

(5) Sirens on Safety Cars - apparently not permitted by Construction Use regs - trying to find a solution for inclusion in SRSRs.

(6) PR requirements prior to Stage and SV events to be changed to consult RLO only.

(7) Use of Hybrid/Electric vehicles out for comment/consideration soon (April). Regulation R does not currently allow for their use for rallies apart from navig events. Need to consider at RCtee level as reg change. Initially "soft intro" permission to run requested thru permit for SV events. Items on handling etc on training hub. Implementation likely Jan 2021. Navig events they can already be used.

(8) Updated Marshals On-Line Module now available on Hub. Try link. No negative comments so far. Will be updated easily.

(9) Officials Module 1 goes live at end of (30th) March. Module 2 will follow later this year.

(10) More intuitive Marshal training Modules to prevent duplication between marshalling disciplines.

(11) Safety Car refresher online trg goes live next few weeks.

(12) Class structure guidelines for Championships for future discussion at RCtee.

- (13) Toilet facilities - going to be recommended in SRSRs for obligation to provide facilities for competitors, officials and spectators also behaviour/decency issues to be addressed.
- (14) Penalty Free Lateness - minimum 15 mins for events with road sections.
- (15) Relaxation of R48.2.1 - V8s
- (16) Carrying of vehicle passports - "should" be in competing vehicle at all times during event.
- (17) Simplification of access to aspects on the MSUK website being undertaken.
- (18) Education/policy/regulation to be considered/strengthened around participating on non-permitted events for MSUK licences.
