2	<u>MOTOR SPORT DEVELOPMENT</u>	
2a	Restarting Motorsport in the Post Covid19 environment, Scottish Government announced new restrictions YESTERDAY "Rule of 6" Dispensations do not seem to apply to motorsport. John Ryan is on it, hope for answer by end of week. Face coverings must be worn by everybody at events – no medical exemptions, because everybody spoken to claimed to have a medical exemption. So no exceptions, if you can't or won't wear a mask, stay at home. Tom Matthews – what is the association doing to persuade Sport Scotland? Looks like nothing? Pete Weall – John Ryan and his team are very much on this case, and they are the best people to do it. Tom – MsUK are not interested in Scotland, doing nothing for us. Only care about British GP and Touring Cars. Pete – the changes happened YESTERDAY; and in the current situation, motorsport is not the biggest priority the government has to consider. Rory Bryant (currently working as a consultant for Motorsport UK) – understands there will be an exemption for motorsport, but the situation is evolving all the time – affected the behind-closed-doors at Knockhill last week. Bill Creevy – can't understand problem when events are outside? Had 30 people curling in an ice rink last week, and equestrian events running? Pete – that all changed YESTERDAY – can't have curling or equestrian events this week. Richard Crozier – What about two people from same household in a car? That seemed to be OK last week, is that ruled out now? Pete – MsUK understood that two in a car would be OK from 14 th Sept (yesterday) when Driving Lessons were permitted by the expected easing of restrictions by the Scottish Government; but restrictions have not been lifted, they have been tightened. You have been told, in good faith, advice

But the government has changed the rules.</p> <p>Richard- there's a dozen clubs here wondering whether they they have to cancel their planned events.</p> <p>But, outside permitted motorsport, there is an event planned this weekend, with motoring content, with 1000 attendees in 5 separate 200 person bubbles. Worry that this could damage the reputation of the real motorsport community in the eyes of public and government, who don't know the difference.</p> <p>Rory – other sports that have an exemption already are exempt from the bubble of 6. Motorsport UK are seeking the same exemption but do not yet have it. Hoped to have it this week.</p> <p>Robert May – Scottish Sporting due to run an event this weekend, will the get a yes or no before then? Will they hear in time to cancel hire of venues and equipment?</p> <p>Need to consider the moral aspect of carrying on in a worsening global pandemic.</p>
