Safeguarding

From RSAC Motorsport:

The Motorsport UK Board signed off a new Safeguarding Children Policy document on 29 July 2020. There is also a new Adults at Risk Policy document, signed off on the same date, plus a new Young Persons Guide to Safeguarding. All these documents refer to Clubs having their own policies and procedures.

An article on Safeguarding appeared in the August issue of Revolution. We would question though whether a publication such as Revolution is the appropriate conduit for the announcement of important governance matters and it is disappointing that there has been no direct communication to clubs and, importantly, their Safeguarding Officers. Our own Safeguarding Officer reports that they get no correspondence from Motorsport UK regarding anything for safeguarding (training, updates, etc), and no training sessions have taken place since the first one a few years ago.

Can we have an update on Safeguarding please, covering, but not exclusively:

- Future communication and support to Club Safeguarding Officers;
- The training programme for Club Safeguarding Officers;
- Plans for proactive engagement direct with Clubs on the new policies;
- The practical assistance to be given to Clubs to enable them to comply with the requirements.
