Marshal's Advisory Group

Background

Since the June update to SAMSC, virtual meetings have been held on 23 June and 10 September.

Key Updates

The following are key updates from the Group:

Roles and responsibilities for the various positions undertaken by marshals have been drafted. Once agreed these will be added to the interactive Marshals Grading Scheme document held on the Motorsport UK website. These will help people looking to progress their marshalling career understand what the different roles are and what training they need to complete in support of the new role.

The MAG is simplifying the training requirements associated with the Marshal Grading Scheme. As a starting point three online modules are being developed covering the basics of marshalling.

The recruitment and retention of marshals is due to be discussed in early 2021.

Talking of 2021, attendees were reminded that all 2020 Marshal Registrations and Official Licences are being extended by 12 months and will be valid until the end of 2021. Marshal upgrade assessments are also currently on hold. For 2021, event attendance signatures already obtained will be valid from 2017, training module signatures from 2018.

Attendees were also reminded that submissions for BMSTT Training Grants should be submitted by 7 October. I have not checked but am assuming that Rupert will be consolidating for SAMSC member clubs as has been done previously.

Next Meeting

No date has been set for the next meeting, but I expect there will be one before the end of the year.
